

Health and Safety Policy statement

At maintenance Services Direct we recognise our duties under the current health and safety legislation and we endeavour to meet the requirements of this legislation to help ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, the health, safety and welfare at work of all employees.

Maintenance Services Direct are fully aware of our responsibilities to ensure we take all reasonable precautions, to ensure the safety and health of those that are likely to be affected by the operation of our business.

Maintenance Services Direct recognises its duties to make suitable and sufficient assessments of the significant risks to the health and safety of those who may be affected in the course of our business.

We also recognise our duty, so far as is reasonably practicable:

1. To meet our legal obligations to maintain safe and healthy working conditions
2. To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks so far identified
3. To consult with all necessary personnel on matters affecting their health and safety
4. To provide and maintain safe plant and equipment
5. To ensure the safe handling and use of substances
6. To provide information, instruction & training where necessary
7. To ensure that all workers are competent to do their work and to give them appropriate training
8. To prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health
9. To actively manage and supervise health and safety at work
10. To have access to competent advice and guidance
11. To seek continuous improvement in our health and safety performance and to carry our reviews on this policy
12. To ensure this policy is effective and implemented at all times

We also recognise:

1. Our duty to co-operate and work closely with others when we work at premises or sites under their control to ensure the continued health and safety of all those at work and
2. Our duty to co-operate and work with other employers and their workers, when their workers come onto our premises or sites to do work for us, to ensure the health and safety of everyone at work

To help achieve our objectives and ensure everyone recognises their duties under the health and safety legislation whilst at work, we will also inform them of their duty to take reasonable care for themselves and for others who might be affected by their activities

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
